The mission of Jubilee Housing is to provide appropriate, secure and affordable housing for people who have connection with the local community and are unable to secure adequate housing from the private sector.

The Brief History

Jubilee Housing Inc. is a community housing management organisation initiated in 1986 by Box Hill Baptist Church and NewHope Baptist Church. Jubilee Housing is an incorporated organisation that manages property on behalf of participating organisations and is currently responsible for three 'joint venture' projects.

The Residents

The residents of Jubilee Housing are low-income households, having some connection with the Whitehorse or Maroondah communities. When a vacancy occurs, an allocation of housing is made to applicants after considering the length of time they have been on the waiting list, their needs and Jubilee's overall aim of developing supportive and peaceful communities.

The Communities



Jubilee Place

Jubilee Place was opened in 1987 and comprises 10 units located in Box Hill North. The units are a mix of 1,2,3 and 4 bedroom dwellings each with a private backyard. The estate has open space and a children's playground.



Figtree Lane

Figtree Lane was opened in 1997 and comprises 10 units located in Burwood. This project also comprises a mix of 1,2 3 and 4 bedroom units. Figtree Lane is situated opposite a village green which provides ample playground space for children.



Emmaus

Emmaus was opened in 2004 and comprises 19 units located in Bayswater North. This project has a mix of 1, 2 and 3 bedroom units. Each home has a large rear grassed garden. There is also a large common area which is enjoyed by the children.
