

Walking Humbly with God sermon study questions

1. What does it mean to be humble? What are the outwards signs of a humble person?
2. What has God done for us that demands our humility? Or, why is humility an important foundation for our relationship with God?
3. Micah 6 states that God is lodging a “case” “against Israel”. What are the Jews’ attitudes towards their worship that God is critical of, and which walking humbly with God will help to address?
4. In what ways might God lodge this same case against us today? In what ways can walking humbly with God also help to transform our attitudes to worship?
5. Taken together, how can the three commands given in Micah 6:8—to act justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with God—change our lives?
