“...to walk humbly with your God” Micah 6:8

To foster a relationship of agreement with God in order to enjoy him and serve him forever.

1. Micah connects his message with some key words and themes that remind us to look back to the beginning of creation, to a time when Adam and Eve walked with God. In 6:8 the Hebrew word translated as “man” is *adam*. See Genesis 2:7. Can you find other connections or themes?
2. To walk with someone presupposes a relationship of some kind, but we see this relationship with God fractured in Genesis 3:8 What was the cause and the result? Has this relationship been fractured forever?
3. Whilst we may find it difficult to go for a walk with famous people, Jesus opens the way for us to walk with our Creator-God. See Colossians 1:21-22. What does this mean to you? What can it mean for our world?
4. Enoch is a bible character who is specially mentioned for his relationship with God. See Genesis 5:21-24. Do you know of people who inspire you in a similar way in their relationship with God? What is it that inspires you?
5. To walk with someone means to leave other things behind (see Luke 9:57-62). Are there things that you need to leave behind in order to walk closer to God?
