HOSEA 1: 1 - 11, JOHN 3:16

1. Read Hosea 1 : 1 - 11. What is it like to be God? Does Hosea experience something of what it is like to be God?
2. Can we liken God's love for Israel to any human thinking or philosophy?
3. Who did God liken Israel to?
4. Gomer's three children were called - "Defeated", "Not loved", "Not my people". Could this have been the result of their parents and grandparents turning away from God?
5. Can the situation be any different? Note the word "yet" or "but the day is coming" in verse 10. Recite the promises of God to His people.
6. With whom did God replace the prophets as a way to speak to His people and make a way back to Himself?
7. Let these verses speak to you about His persistent love for a broken world - 1 John 3 : 1 ; 1 Peter 2 : 10.
