Jeremiah 13 : 1 - 17.

1. How does a nation give God glory?
2. With some of the great nations of the world today that draw a lot of glory to themselves, what do they do with that glory?
3. Read verses 1 to 11. What are the principle points in the lesson that God is wanting to teach the Israelites through Jeremiah? Concentrate on verse 11.
4. God had always expected the Israelites to practice maximum alignment to His will with minimum self-interest. He called them to be a holy nation, set apart, and a kingdom of priests. What would our nation be like if we practiced these Godly principles?
5. We are called to be dual citizens. How can we do this? We are called to be a Kingdom of priests within the nation of Australia. How can we do this?
6. Do we see the world as God sees it? "Let our hearts be broken by the things that break the heart of God!"

7. Jeremiah was called on by God to be critical of the king because he was selfish and unjust. What happens when our current leaders get caught up in self-interest?
