4. What was (and is) God’s desire for this world and its people?
5. What part did Zechariah and Elizabeth play in God’s plan to help restore the messy world to God’s order?
6. Why did Elizabeth refer to her childless state as her disgrace? (Luke 1 : 25)
7. What are the messy things about our secret selves that we can’t talk about to others?
8. Imagine for a moment what a perfect existence in a perfect world would look like? Or is that too difficult to imagine?
9. How do you personally add to the mess of a fallen world?
10. Does God only wait until we have our lives in order to meet us?
11. When can we expect to find God? (Romans 5:8)
