Psalm 139

1. Read Psalm 139 and identify which verses and phrases describe God's attributes of omniscience, omnipresence, omnipotence.
2. How does the fact that (a) God knows all about us, in absolute detail, (b) He is passionately concerned about the renewal of our heart, help or hinder us to be vulnerable and open up our hearts before Him?
3. David recognises the Holiness and Righteousness of God and is convicted of his sin. Ref. Hab 1:13a and also scan Psalm 51. How does a focus on God's holiness and righteousness impact you as you reflect on your life?
4. "Search me" (v 1, 23) is a forensic term: like a courtroom. David says, put me in the dock, Lord. Identify EVERY sin! Discover me: test me - put me through the fire of refinement "I want to be pure in heart" - What if we stood in front of God's absolute Holiness – (a) What might He say to you? (b) How might you respond?
5. Read Romans 8:1-2 How do these verses in the light of previous questions set you free and give you unimaginable hope for the future?
6. As a final reflection on Psalm 139, which verses mean most to you and that you could meditate on during the week?
7. How has God spoken to you during the five part sermon series with Tim Meyers, "God looks at the heart"? What do you intend doing about it?
