2 Chronicles 20:1-30

It's a Matter of Life and Death

1. Read 2 Chronicles 20:1-30 and look for all the examples of different people praising God and recognising His greatness. King Jehoshaphat did not know what to do but he wisely recognised that The Lord would know, so what did he do to find out God's will? What was the reason God allowed the vast army to come to attack Israel and was Israel at fault? Does God allow us to face very serious trials and if so why does He, even if we have not caused the situation to occur?
2. Allan said "Isn't knowledge a wonderful thingGod is interested in us and he interacts with usGod is not lost His heart is good toward us We need to praise Him with Hallelujah each day." Can you share an example where you have had your back to the wall and you have remembered to praise the Lord God Almighty then you saw the circumstances change around you in an amazing way , as He gave you knowledge of what to do ? If not can you share another person's story where God intervened in an amazing way ? What impact did this have on your faith?
3. What impact did the message Jahaziel gave to the Israelites have on their attitude and how did it reflect in how they went into battle and how they later worshipped God? How powerful can an " attitude of Praise " be when we seek knowledge from God and how should we pray when we need God's knowledge to handle a situation big or small?
4. Read Acts 12: 1-2 and 20-24 . What is the contrast between King Jehoshaphat and King Herod in the way they related to their people and to God and what was the difference relating to their personal character and attitude ? Read Deuteronomy 8: 6-20 and ask yourself where do I stand in regards to wealth and power in relation to how should I approach God at all times and do I praise Him enough?
