“Reconciliation Week”

2 Cor: 5, 11-21

1. Read the chapter above. Scott gave us a challenge to be reconciled and he gave us an acronym “FLUTE” as being a key to reconciliation so what do the verses 18-20 mean to us in regards to reconciling with all people.
How did hearing this make you feel regarding your relationship to God and to other people and in particular to indigenous people and your own life and service for Him?
Share stories about how your relationship with God has changed the way you relate to your friends and other people from different nationalities?
2. Read John 15: 9-17. Discuss how do you understand love in the light of these verses? What are the requirements Jesus wants from us if we really are His friend and how should this cause us to love other nationalities in particular with indigenous nationalities [Scott says there are 53 different Aboriginal Nations in Australia]?
3. Read Mark 11:25-26. Discuss what is happening to the world today are we seeing people becoming more or less forgiving? If not why is this? What can we in the church and individually do to really demonstrate Jesus’s love to others by showing forgiveness?
4. Read Col:1: 9-14. How do these verses speak to you about understanding and doing God’s will and how can we empathise with all of God’s people from all nationalities?
