1. Why do you think it seemed so unusual that Peter spoke the way he did?
2. Please read Joel 2:28-32. Joel spoke of a time when the Spirit would be available to every believer. As these words were written approx. 800 years before the birth of Jesus, why do you think his words appeared to be so unusual?
3. What do you think "before that great and glorious day of the Lord arrives" means in 2 Acts 2:20?
4. Both Acts and Joel mention "your young men will see visions" and "your old men will dream dreams". What do you think this means and what is the position for women?
5. What do you think was meant by verses 19 and 20 in Acts?
6. Please refer to Numbers 11:29. What thoughts have you on this?
7. A New Testament believer has privileges that did not exist prior to Pentecost. Discuss what you think about this statement.
8. Look at the title to this message. What do you think "Seeing and Dreaming God's New Creation" means? Is it just a catchy Title, or can you see something more in it?
9. Do you think there is more to happen than is mentioned in the Joel verses? Please discuss.
10. What do you think is the full implication of verse 21 in Acts?
11. How do you think "religion" gets in the way of "intimacy" or "relationship" in these verses?
