John 2:5

From John 2:5: In what way does Mary view Jesus as precious?

How does Isa 61:10 and Col 3:12 illustrate the preciousness of Christ?

- (b) What does it mean to 'put on these new garments'?
- (c) What do we do/might we do in order to walk with Jesus every day? (Ref Mat 11:28-30, John 7:38)

How does being regarded as precious by Jesus impact you?
