Jesus through the eyes of Judas

Matthew 27:1 - 10

1. Have you ever felt remorse? What were the circumstances?
2. The Scriptures don't tell us a lot about Judas. What do you know about him? (Judas calls Jesus "Rabbi". The other disciples call him "Lord" and "God".)
3. Why do you think that Jesus named Judas as a betrayer? (Luke 22 : 21)
4. What was Judas sin?
5. If all of the disciples failed Jesus, why was Judas' failure considered greater than the others?
6. What motivated Judas? (John 12 : 4 - 6)
7. Judas was a revolutionary. He did not agree with Jesus avoiding a confrontational approach. He wasn't willing to just follow Jesus. Can we equate this to your own sinfulness, your own failure?
8. Consider that Judas tried to marry his aspirations with Jesus power! We can marry our sins with Jesus' innocence!
9. What would cause Judas to hang himself?
10. Can you see the sadness of Judas' final action before Jesus' resurrection, which would have given him the perfect opportunity for forgiveness?
